## HOLY CROSS HOSPITAL MEDICAL STAFF DONATE MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT FOR CONTINUING BAHAMAS RELIEF EFFORTS

Bahamian Government Officials Visit Holy Cross Hospital To View Gifted Medical Unit And Tour Hospital Facilities

Fort Lauderdale, FL – October 17 2019 – Iram D. Lewis, Minister of State for Disaster Preparedness, Management & Reconstruction, Katherine B. Smith, President of the Senate & NEMA Coordinator Grand Bahama Island, Carl Smith, Permanent Secretary (Ministry of Disaster Preparedness, Management & Reconstruction) and Carl Oliver, Director (Ministry of Disaster Preparedness, Management & Reconstruction) visited Holy Cross Hospital at 8:00 am Friday Oct 18<sup>th</sup> to view the Medical Mobile Truck donated by Holy Cross Hospital medical staff. The principal sponsors of the Bahamas Relief Effort organized by the Holy Cross medical team include Mission Resolve Foundation, Tropic Oil, The Kotler Family, Medical Outfitters Inc., Quality Air Conditioning Co., Picture Perfect Signs and LRM Leasing.

The medical unit has an on board generator, two air conditioners, refrigerator, water, and has fuel capacity for one week. Additional funds have been raised to also maintain the unit and supplies which include sanitary materials, water, MREs and tarps for sun cover.

The Bahamian government representatives met with the hospital team, among them Douglas Strong, Interim President CEO, Consultant Executive, RHM HCH/Trinity Health and Jon A. Kotler, MD, President Chief of Medical Staff, Director Nuclear Medicine.

In total, the Medical Staff is donating \$150,000 in hardware to the Bahamas and will be donating another \$20,000 - \$30,000 in the short term.

"Holy Cross Hospital Medical Staff is pleased to donate a mobile disaster response medical clinic to the Bahama Ministry of Disaster Preparedness Management & Reconstruction. The mobile medical clinic is self-contained with on-board generator, air conditioning, water, commode, expanding side walls with stairwell and elevator access" said Dr. Jon Kotler, President Chief of Medical Staff at Holy Cross Hospital

The Medical Mobile Unit will be shipped to the island of Abaco, Bahama by Seacor Island Lines to help aid in the continuing recovery efforts.
